*India:* Pastor David reports that the orphans are doing well. Thanks to the generosity of NHMI supporters, they were able to pay off all unpaid bills and purchase all of school supplies needed for the second term.



The church where Pastor David ministers continues to grow and they are preparing for a baptism service for the new believers.

Pastor Edwin has been looking for land to purchase for a new well and church building for his young, growing church in Haryana state, India. In October, he found a piece of land across from a future school. He needed \$8,400 for the land, taxes, registration, and well installation. A family who wanted to support a well pledged \$3,500 for that purpose. Pastors Dale and Jeanne were blessed to attend a missions conference in Ohio during the last week of October where attendees and other missionaries pledged the remaining amount. Praise the Lord! Pray that the licensing and work go smoothly.

*Tanzania:* The government provided Pastor Laban with 300 young cashew trees, which he will be transplanting onto ten acres of the plantation. Along with the last crop that is quickly growing, he will now have a total of twenty acres of cashew trees that he will cultivate. He plants beans and groundnuts between the trees to prevent bushes from growing and crowding them out. When the cashews are harvested, they will be sold to the government processing facility nearby. This project, along with the other fruit trees and ground crops already established, is another way of providing valuable income for the ministry. \$2,000 will help him continue this year's planting season operations and help to clear more land for cultivation.



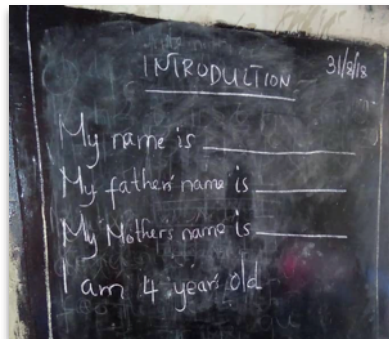
On November 30, the Nyargusu Refugee Camp Church choir launched their first video music album consisting of eight songs with money that they raised.



The public in Mpanda is becoming more aware of the medical dispensary and are grateful for the valuable health services that they provide. The dispensary currently needs some surgical room light fixtures, laboratory equipment, updated blood pressure cuffs, hospital beds with bedding, and other essential medical equipment.



The nursery school is growing with a current enrollment of 62 students. They teach the children English and about the love of their savior, Jesus Christ. They are currently closed for the Christmas holidays and will resume classes on January 6, 2020. They need a mini bus to raise the quality of education by allowing the classes to travel off campus, and to provide transportation for prospective students who do not live in the immediate neighborhood to attend. The cost for the bus will be \$6,500.
