Pastor Edwin has begun construction on the newly purchased land in Haryana state. After a restroom and reservoir are completed, he will drill the well and attach an electric motor to the reservoir, allowing the people access the water from the well.

The convention center construction is progressing nicely. They are leveling ground for a separate kitchen building, as well as building corner walls by the street. Plastering, electrical and flooring will come next. The annual conference has been postponed to April 30-May 3. The prime minister has ordered that all citizens must be in their homes from 7 AM to 9 PM. Pastor David's church began holding meetings from 4-6 AM. Schools and colleges have also been closed temporarily.

They are having difficulty obtaining electricity for the churches in

Sriviliputhur and Ambai. Please pray that the Lord will touch the hearts of the authorities and they will grant this request.









Pastor Laban reports that the government unexpectedly gave him enough cashew trees to cover 50 acres. This is almost three times more than he expected. This surprise blessing caused him to rearrange his work schedule and use more of his available funds to hire workers to plant the trees, as they needed to be planted as soon as possible. They now have a total of 70 acres of cashews that will provide valuable income for the NHM Tanzania ministry and pastors. They also have eight acres of corn, beans, and groundnuts that are growing well.

The 31 students in the nursery school are doing well. When they purchase a school bus, they will be able to transport more students from the surrounding villages.

The churches continue to grow. In the Arusha area alone, there are 27 registered NHMT churches. They see this kind of growth in all of their ministry centers. Heavy rains collapsed a small church in Tabora and they are waiting for the ground to dry to build another church structure.

The families in Pastor Laban's church continue to support orphans and children who lack support from their families. Please pray for these families and healing for these precious children.

Tanzania cont d: According to our most recent update from Pastor Laban, only 12 people in Tanzania have been affected by COVID 19 with no deaths. The churches are still allowed to meet but not shake hands. They use hand sanitizer and water with chlorine in the church. Join us in praying for protection and the eradication of this virus.
