Pastor David shares that the orphan children are doing very well. Soon, they will be in the middle of taking their 10th grade written exams! They would greatly appreciate prayers as they study in preparation for the test and for good grades to be the outcome!

As the boys progress in their studies, the work on the fence around the orphanage continues as well. The **front side is complete** and they are turning their attentions to finishing the southern portion to prevent animals from getting in and eating their plants and vegetables.

The school work in Dehradun at the Elizabeth Day School is also going well. They continue to pray and believe for the provision of a larger vehicle to accommodate the needs of all the children.

The work at Mambakkam is growing! Many people are regularly attending the prayer meetings. Pastor David is believing that God will open hearts to come and know Jesus as Lord and afterwards to come and be baptized at the upcoming General Convention.

On December 24th, Pastor David will be traveling to Jaipur with Suresh, the mason who helped build the prayer house there. They will be servicing the bore well and then leading a Gospel meeting. During construction of the prayer house, Suresh had the opportunity to meet many locals whom he hopes to invite to the meeting!

Additionally, they continue to stay busy servicing other bore wells throughout several villages to ensure they stay in proper working order and continue providing clean water to those who depend on them.
