NEW HARVEST MINISTRY PROVIDES:

In AFRICA, New Harvest runs 6 branches of the New Harvest Bible College, with over 1,300 graduates. It has helped establish 238 churches in Tanzania, Burundi, Kenya, Uganda, Malawi, and the Democratic Republic of Congo. Additionally, it operates a medical clinic, a nursery school, two cafes, a metal fabrication shop, a brick manufacturing facility, a 3,000-acre agricultural project, and is providing freshwater wells in remote villages.

In INDIA, New Harvest supports orphans and widows, operates a day school, provides Care Centers for children, trains pastors, conducts gospel outreaches in remote villages, and offers vocational training for widows. Graduates from its Bible college have planted over 90 churches, and more than 100 wells have been drilled, providing fresh water to over 100,000 people.

ANTI-CONVERSION LAWS:
As of mid-2025, 13 out of 28 Indian states enforce strict, vaguely worded anti-conversion laws that result in the targeting of Christians and other minority groups such as Muslims. These regulations impose harsh penalties, with certain offenses carrying sentences of up to life imprisonment.

FOREIGN FUNDING RESTRICTIONS:
In June 2025, the Ministry of Home Affairs issued colodifications explicitly banning NGOs from using foreign funds for proselytizing and tightened the framework for faith-based charity organizations.

INSTITUTIONAL AND CAMPUS SURVEILLANCE:
State administrations have begun directing universities to establish "conversion prevention cells" to monitor student activities and hostels to prevent non-bailable, forced conversions.

COMMUNAL VIOLENCE:
Across regions like Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh, Hindu nationalist groups routinely disrupt house churches and private religious conventions, often detaining attendees under allegations of forced conversions.

SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC BOYCOTTS:
Reports detail targeted communal violence against minorities and systematic campaigns of exclusion, including the denial of communal water sources and livelihood opportunities for Christian families.

Uttar Pradesh:
The state has seen prominent convictions under its strict anti-conversion law, including five-year prison sentences and hefty fines imposed on Christian individuals.

Bihar:
Bihar and Odisha face persecution as well, including attacks on churches and individuals.

Chhattisgarh:
Continues to see lethal physical assaults on worshippers, village expulsions, and denial of burial rights. House churches have been ethnically burned in several areas, leaving believers unprotected.

Odisha:
Bihar and Odisha face persecution as well, including attacks on churches and individuals.

Manipur:
Deep ethnic and religious divides persist following mass violence, with Christian Kuki ongoing displacements, armal ambushes, and targeted kidnapping.
