India: Pastor Edwin Jeyakumar is the youngest of the Varghese brothers. During his first year of college, God burdened his heart for Northern India, particularly the state of Haryana. He states that it has the second lowest percentage of Christianity in India. He did not know anyone from the state, so one night he spent in prayer, he asked God for a contact from Haryana. Within two days, a friend from his third year asked him if he would like to do his mission work in Haryana. God's answer to his prayer brought tears to his eyes.

After graduating with his Master of Divinity, he married Deepthi and had a child. In October of 2017, he moved his family into a small rental home in Haryana, more than 1,600 miles away from his brothers David and John in Tamil Nadu. Two weeks later, a neighboring family visited them and told a story about a vision that they had received a month before. The vision involved a family with one child who would be living in front of their home. Edwin and Deepthi shared the Gospel with them and they accepted Jesus Christ as their savior! Edwin and Deepthi are now leading a growing Bible study in their home, as well as working with a Bible translation ministry to have the Bible translated into the Bagadi language. Pray for their mission work in this largely unreached area.
